1 Section 1. Section 423.2, subsection 11, Code Supplement
2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 11. a. All Except as provided in paragraph "b", all
4 revenues arising under the operation of the provisions of this
5 section shall be deposited into the general fund of the state.

6 b. Revenues arising from the tax in this section imposed
7 on the sale of horses shall be credited and are appropriated
8 to the state equine development commission.

9 Sec. 2. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVENESS. This Act is contingent
10 upon and takes effect only upon the establishment of a state
11 equine development commission pursuant to an Act enacted
12 during the Eighty-first General Assembly, 2006 Session.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides for the appropriation of sales tax
15 revenues generated from the sale of horses to the state equine
16 development commission. The bill is contingently effective
17 upon the establishment of such commission during the 2006
18 legislative session.
