**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to lifetime hunting or fishing licenses for  
2 veterans who were disabled or were prisoners of war during  
3 their military service and providing for fees.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 2303 as follows:  
2 1. Page 1, line 3, by striking the word "thirty"  
3 and inserting the following: "thirty five".  
4 2. Page 1, by striking lines 4 through 9 and  
5 inserting the following: "lifetime fishing license or  
6 lifetime hunting and fishing combined license, the  
7 department shall issue a lifetime fishing license or  
8 lifetime hunting and fishing combined license to a  
9 resident of Iowa who is a veteran, as defined".  
10 3. Page 1, by striking lines 15 and 16 and  
11 inserting the following: "lifetime fishing license or  
12 lifetime hunting and fishing combined license under  
13 this".  
14 4. Title page, by striking lines 1 through 3 and  
15 inserting the following: "An Act relating to hunting  
16 and fishing licenses for certain veterans."

1 Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 13, Code Supplement  
2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 13. Upon payment of the fee of thirty dollars for a  
4 lifetime hunting and fishing combined license, or payment of  
5 the fee of sixteen dollars for either a lifetime fishing  
6 license or lifetime hunting license, the department shall  
7 issue a lifetime hunting and fishing combined license,  
8 lifetime fishing license, or lifetime hunting license, as  
9 applicable, to a resident of Iowa who is a veteran, as defined  
10 in section 35.1, or served in the armed forces of the United  
11 States for a minimum aggregate of ninety days of active  
12 federal service and who was disabled or was a prisoner of war  
13 during that veteran's military service. The department shall  
14 prepare an application to be used by a person requesting a  
15 lifetime hunting and fishing combined license, lifetime  
16 fishing license, or lifetime hunting license under this  
17 subsection. The department of veterans affairs shall assist  
18 the department in verifying the status or claims of applicants  
19 under this subsection. As used in this subsection, "disabled"  
20 means entitled to compensation under the United States Code,  
21 Title 38, ch. 11.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill allows a resident who is a veteran, as defined in  
24 Code section 35.1, or served in the armed forces of the United  
25 States for a minimum aggregate of 90 days of active federal  
26 service and who was disabled or was a prisoner of war during  
27 that military service, to purchase either a lifetime fishing  
28 license or a lifetime hunting license for \$16.
