1 Section 1. Section 68A.402, subsection 1, Code Supplement
2 2005, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. FILING METHODS. Each committee shall file with the
4 board reports disclosing information required under this
5 section on forms prescribed by rule. Reports shall be filed
6 on or before the required due dates by using any of the
7 following methods: mail bearing a United States postal
8 service postmark, hand-delivery, facsimile transmission, or
9 electronic filing as prescribed by rule. A report that is
10 required to be filed five days before an election must be
11 physically received by the board by that date to be considered
12 timely filed. This requirement does not apply to a
13 supplementary report under subsection 2, paragraph "b".

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill requires a report, except for supplementary
16 reports filed by statewide office and legislative candidates,
17 that is required to be filed five days prior to an election to
18 be received in the office of the ethics and campaign
19 disclosure board to be considered timely filed.
