13 in Des Moines, where he luckily met an Iowa girl,
14 Betty Bubon, who consented to be his wife in 1949; and

16 studies, Mr. Wasker graduated from Drake University
17 in 1951 and Drake University Law School in 1952; and
18 WHEREAS, Mr. Wasker was admitted to the practice of
19 law in Iowa in 1952, and in 1955 began his practice as
20 a lobbyist to the General Assembly; and
21 WHEREAS, Mr. Wasker has continued in that role for
22 every session of the General Assembly for the past 50
23 years while his wife, Betty, served for over 20 years
24 as a clerk in the House and a secretary in the Senate;

26 WHEREAS, during that remarkable tenure, Mr. Wasker
27 has demonstrated the highest standard of integrity;
