RENTER'S CREDIT SUBCOMMITTEE
of the
SENATE AND HOUSE COMMITTEES ON WAYS AND MEANS

The six member Renter's Credit Subcommittee authorized by the Legislative Council on July 14, 1977 has met for one day during the 1977 interim. The Subcommittee has one more meeting authorized by the Council but as of this date, no meeting has been scheduled. Members of the Subcommittee are: Senators Fred W. Nolting, Co-Chairperson, David M. Readinger, and James M. Redmond, and Representatives Robert T. Anderson, Co-Chairperson, John H. Clark, and B. Joseph Rinas.

During the morning of its October 31 meeting, the Subcommittee heard testimony from persons interested in renter's credit legislation. Also at the meeting the Legislative Service Bureau staff provided information to the Subcommittee on laws of other states and the Department of Revenue provided fiscal data requested by the Subcommittee.

The Subcommittee agreed that a renter's credit proposal should be developed and requested that the Legislative Service Bureau obtain information from other states concerning costs of renter's credit programs in those states and requested that the Department of Revenue develop a breakdown of renters by age and income levels if possible for the next meeting of the Subcommittee.
